**WHEN:** Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday 3:30pm – 5:30pm March 28 – May 20 weather permitting.

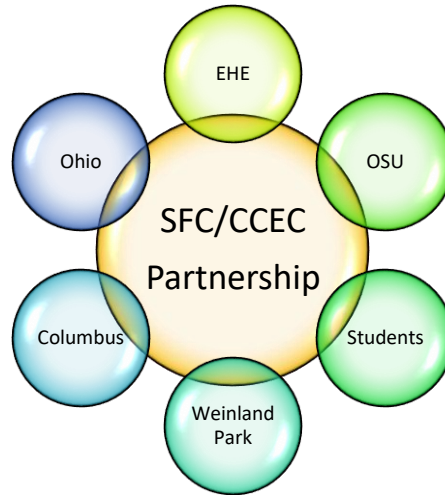
