**General Updates:**

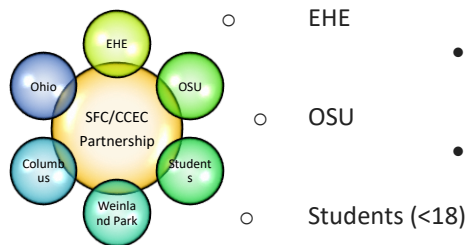
- OSU Accessibility policy. Qualtrics survey designer contains several question types that cannot be read or responded to by people who rely on assistive technology. These “non-accessible” questions do not comply with Ohio State’s web/digital accessibility policy. OSU will bring Qualtrics in to compliance by disabling non-accessible survey question types for all users. Qualtrics users need to review active surveys and either revise inaccessible items or request an exemption prior to July 1 in order to avoid disruption in data collection.
