Professionals from The Ohio State University are offering **free developmental screenings** for all children ages 0-5 years currently enrolled in our center. During these screenings, a developmental professional will briefly meet your child and complete play-based tasks to see how your child is learning and developing. These professionals may also ask your child’s classroom teacher to provide information about how your child acts during class time and interacts with his/her peers.

The purpose of a developmental screening is to:

- Identify children who might need more developmental support
- Refer children with developmental concerns for further evaluation or services
